Behavioural standards for

PARENTS & GUARDIANS

TEACH my child

- Treat everyone equally regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political affiliation
- · Do not force an unwilling participant to take part in basketball
- Encourage everyone to play by the rules and respect the game officials
- Teach that effort and teamwork are as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment
- Remember that young people and vulnerable adults learn best by example
- · Refrain from publicly questioning the judgement or honesty of game officials

RESPECT for myself and others

- Treat everyone equally regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political affiliation
- Support all efforts to remove verbal, physical and racist abuse from basketball
- Remember that young people are involved for their enjoyment not yours
- · Never ridicule or shout at a participant for making a mistake or losing a game
- Do not shout abuse at officials, coaches, players or other spectators
- Do not demonstrate any aggressive or threatening behaviour towards anybody in the basketball community, including Basketball England members of staff
- Raise concerns to the correct person without delay camp director, welfare officer etc, irrespective of their age, sex and/or gender, race etc.

Consequences of POOR DEHAYIOUR

- · Verbal warning
- · Written warning
- Removal from the premises
- Removal from all Talent activity (subject to the review of a complaint)
- Physical violence, aggressive and threatening behaviour towards anyone is NEVER TOLERATED and you
 will be removed immediately, which may have implications on the rest of your journey on the
 Basketball England Talent Pathway
- · Incidents of criminality will be reported to the police
- Basketball England's disciplinary team will be informed of incidents which fall below those expected, or which breach the code of ethics and conduct
